Welcome to the Flatlands Equestrian Center Schooling Event, Combined Test and Dressage Show!

You are taking part in a new type of schooling event with a design-your-own cross-country course with your option of dressage test and jumping height. The event has been designed to be learning experience for both the horse and rider, utilizing our new cross-country schooling field and expanding stadium course. We hope that everyone has a fun and safe day while enjoying the sport of eventing.

Governing Rules:

The Flatlands Equestrian Center Schooling Event is run under the rules of the USEA and though the trials are for schooling purposes, all rules will be followed, and any changes will be made only at the discretion of the management. If you are unfamiliar with these rules, the organizers of these horse trials strongly recommend that you become familiar with all rules pertaining to the sport of eventing. FEC strongly recommends membership in the USEA. As members you will receive the USEA Omnibus, USEA Rule Book, Medical Card and US Eventing magazine among other benefits. More information is available at the secretary's booth. FEC Schooling Events are a wonderful way to gain experience in eventing and we invite any and all participants, parents and owners to join us in volunteering.

1. Proper headgear is required at all times when mounted (helmets with soft visor and chin strap).
2. Protective vests are required for the cross-country phase. (If you don't own one, borrow from a friend.)
3. No unauthorized assistance on the course at any time.
4. Warm-up gear prohibits use of chambons, standing martingales, balancing reins, etc. See USEA for rules for further details.

****Cross-Country Phase**** The cross country course is a design-your-own course. A map has been provided, indicating the jumps that may be jumped and the direction they can be jumped. Competitors will leave from the start box, jump 10-12 efforts and must cross through the finish flags. Penalties for refusals, run-outs, etc. will follow the USEA rules. Rides are scheduled five minutes apart, however, riders have a maximum of ten minutes to complete the efforts. You can jump all of the jumps in the field, the same one ten times or any combination you please- but be aware of the direction of the flags and do not forget to cross the finish!

Flatlands Turnout Award

This award is given to the rider who the judge feels has done an excellent job cleaning and preparing their horse (and themselves) for the Dressage phase. The winner will receive a special award designed to help prepare their horse for their next event.

In honor of our FEC school horse Ollie, this award recognizes that even those with the “less-than-perfect” dressage test can still move up many placings with a clear cross-country and stadium round.
